Bathtub Rules

All Motorized and Non-Motorized Entries

1. You must use a commercially manufactured bathtub. If these bathtubs have four legs you should remove the legs. Tubs must be a complete bathtub able to hold a minimum of 40 gallons of water up to the rim with all facet, overflow, and drain holes plugged.
2. The bottom two inches (2") of the tub must be painted a safety orange. The tub must draw at least that at rest in the water with crew in tub. A crew member must be in the tub during the race.
3. Flotation must be able to buoy the tub and crew.
4. Human muscle, wind, or a combination of wind and human power can propel the tub.
5. Each entry must have a minimum of a 3" diameter metal **Tow Ring 1/4 inch** thick in the center of the most forward or aft end of the entry bathtub. It must be readily accessible for a tow boat or watercraft to snap onto with a rope in order to tow the bathtub to the starting line or back to the dock.
6. Each entry must have a 3/8" diameter anchor rope or line at least 50 ft in length attached to the tub. This line must have a float or buoy attached to the other end.
7. Each team/crew member **must wear** a US Coast Guard approved **Personal Flotation Device** (no belts or inflatable life preservers) **at all times** when in or about the water. All Nevada Department of Wildlife Boating Regulations must be adhered to.
8. The name and/or assigned entry number must be prominently displayed on both sides of the tub. It is recommended that the letters or numbers be large enough to be visible to the race officials and spectators.
9. The race will be held at Cave Lake State Park on Saturday, June 24, 2017 between 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. all entries must be signed-in prior to 1:00 p.m.
10. No tub can be fitted with, towed or pushed along with any type or style of watercraft. Example: motor boat, canoe, or jet-ski. The judges will have final say on any decision in regards to this or any rule. If you have a question please contact us prior to the event.

Motorized Entries

1. Each tub propelled by a gas or electric motor must have the motor securely attached to the entry.
2. All batteries whether used for starting or power must be sealed or AGM type; and strapped onto the entry. **No acid type batteries will be permitted!**
3. All fuel tanks must be secured to the tub and capped. In case the tub sinks we do not want fuel leakage into the lake while we retrieve the tub.
4. There will be categories or classes based on the horsepower of the different entries. For example 1 to 10 horse power, 10 to 20 and so on.
5. All motors must be off prior to manning or exiting the tub.

***The judges reserve the right to make final decisions based upon their discretion.**

***Final instructions and course rules will be given the day of the event due to the possibility of inclement weather.**

General Rules

All Motorized and Non-Motorized Entries

- You must use a commercially manufactured bathtub. If these bathtubs have four legs you should remove the legs.
- The bottom two inches (2") of the tub must be painted a safety orange. The tub must draw at least 2" at rest in the water with crew in tub.
- Flotation must be able to buoy the tub and crew.
- Human muscle, wind, or a combination of wind and human power can propel the tub.
- Each entry must have a minimum of a 3" diameter metal Tow Ring ¼ inch thick in the center of the most forward or aft end of the entry bathtub. It must be readily accessible for a tow boat or watercraft to snap onto with a rope in order to tow the bathtub to the starting line or back to the dock.
- Each entry must have a 3/8" diameter anchor rope or line at least 50 ft. in length attached to the tub. This line must have a float or buoy attached to the other end.
- Each team/crew member **must wear** a US Coast Guard approved **Personal Flotation Device at all times** when in or about the water (no belts or inflatable life preservers).
- No alcoholic beverages allowed in the tubs while on the water.
- The name and/or assigned entry number must be prominently displayed on both sides of the tub. It is recommended that the letters or numbers be large enough to be visible to the race officials and spectators.
- The mandatory inspection and show will be held Friday evening, June 23, 2017 at a predetermined location. Arrangements for inspection must be made if you are unable to attend the Friday evening event.
- The race will be held at Cave Lake State Park on Saturday, June 24, 2017 between 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. All entries must be signed-in prior to 11 a.m.
- No tub can be fitted with, towed or pushed along with any type or style of watercraft. Example: motor boat, canoe, or jet-ski. The judges will have final say on any decision in regards to this or any rule. If you have a question please contact us prior to the event.

Motorized Entries

- Each tub propelled by a gas or electric motor must have the motor securely attached to the entry.
- Each tub propelled by a gas motor must have a marine kill switch with lanyard.
- All batteries whether used for starting or power must be sealed or AGM type; and strapped onto the entry. **No acid type batteries will be permitted!**
- All fuel tanks must be secured to the tub and capped. In case the tub sinks we do not want fuel leakage into the lake while we retrieve the tub.
- There will be categories or classes based on the horsepower of the different entries. For example: 1 to 10 horse power, 10 to 20 and so on.
- All motors must be off prior to manning or exiting the tub.
